This is a formal notification of the **2015 Annual General Meeting** which will take place on **Friday, 6<sup>th</sup> November** in the **Dixon Suite** at **Old Mill Hall, Grove**, starting at **7:30pm**.

The Committee has agreed that the notification will be by email this year.

**Please take the time to read the AGM notification.** The Committee is not proposing to increase the Club's portion of the subscription fee for 2016 above its 2015 level. However, the England Athletics affiliation fee has tended to increase annually, approximately in line with inflation. Hence this portion of the Annual Subscription will be increased, as agreed at last year's AGM.

On the Agenda will be a discussion on a charitable donation from the 2017 White Horse Half Marathon. It has been customary for the Club to support local charities. If you wish to propose a suitable charity, please notify Lori or myself, ideally before the meeting.

We are also proposing a short discussion on the Way Forward for the Club. Issues, which have been discussed recently in this respect, include:

- i) Long term coaching provisions with the need to encourage more members to obtain accredited coaching qualifications and the demand for Junior coaching, including from U11s. The Club also has a demand for qualified officials to support its participation in local and regional competitions;
- ii) Social events;
- iii) Competition and training and particularly the need to encourage more members to participate in Club teams in local events;
- iv) The longer term provision of local training facilities for the Club;
- v) Jog Wantage and a Wantage Park Run; and
- vi) Development of a wider Club membership.

Again, if you have any views or ideas on these or other issues of interest, please use this opportunity to raise and discuss them.

We also still urgently **need people to come forward to assist with the running of White Horse Harriers AC**. Currently the Club is run by a very small number of willing members. We need a Committee with the broadest range of members, in order that we can ensure that we fully serve the wishes and interests of the members.
